## Corporate Confession of Sin found in Prone to Wander (2014)


As we come to you today to confess our weakness and rebellion against you, we thank you that you have chosen to love desperate sinners like ourselves. Your love and determination to rescue us from our sin give us the courage to admit the profound depravity of our desires, thoughts, and actions. We are people who want our kingdoms to come and our will to be done. Instead of pursuing spiritual wisdom with all our strength, we are delighted by our own wisdom and impressed with our own understanding. We despise your will because it is so much stronger than ours and reminds us that we are not the gods we wish to be. We want to be worthy of your love, instead of resting in the radiant worthiness of your Son. Father, forgive us. Give us spiritual wisdom to behold our risen Lamb, perfect, spotless, and worthy to receive all our worship, adoration, and praise.

#### Call to Confession

As we see God in His invitation and our praise, we cannot help but see how we have fallen short. God's Holy Scripture has the authority to reveal us to ourselves and transition our hearts to confession.

#### Corporate Confession of Sin

We sin in thought, word, and deed every week. This prayer, sometimes individual and silent confession, is a corporate confession uniting our voices as people equally and desperately in need of God's grace.



### Assurance of Pardon

Scripture Lesson

We hear and read Holy Scripture throughout the service. Listen to this reading (lesson) to prepare for the sermon.

#### Doxology

A doxology is a hymn or word of praise to God for His goodness and glory. The *Gloria Patri* is another example of a doxology.

#### Presentation of Tithes & Offerings

We set aside a tithe and additional offering of our resources for the purposes of God, for His glory. Both are a display of our joyful dependence upon God rather than our selves.

#### Prayer of the Church

We share in our health and sickness, happiness and sorrow, assurance and doubt, as we bring our prayers to God, together. Holy Scripture commands elders to pray with and for God's people, not just publicly, but privately.

#### Scripture Lesson

We hear and read Holy Scripture throughout the service. Follow along with this text (lesson) that directs the sermon.

#### Sermon

A preacher is commanded to faithfully steward God's Word by submitting to it, studying it, and expositing it (holding it forth), bearing witness to Jesus, by the power of the Holy Spirit.

#### **Confession of Faith**

By confessing our faith together using statements believed by Christians over the ages, we join in the sweep of Christian history even as we await the return of Jesus.

### Scripture Lesson

John 8.31-38 (p. 894)

<sup>31</sup> So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, <sup>32</sup> and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
<sup>33</sup> They answered him, "We are offspring of Abraham and have never been enslaved to anyone. How is it that you say, 'You will become free'?"

<sup>34</sup> Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin. <sup>35</sup> The slave does not remain in the house forever; the son remains forever. <sup>36</sup> So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. <sup>37</sup> I know that you are offspring of Abraham; yet you seek to kill me because my word finds no place in you. <sup>38</sup> I speak of what I have seen with my Father, and you do what you have heard from your father."

### UPDATE FROM CPC MISSIONARIES IN INDIA

Drs. Sujai & Lavanya Suneetha



After years of ministry among lepers in India, Drs. Sujai & Lavanya Suneetha responded to God's call to minister to those infected and affected by HIV/AIDS (India's lowest "caste"). Under the Suneethas' dedicated and capable leadership, *Nireekshana* started in June 2004 in a small way as an out-patient based clinic in the front rooms of their home. [Seed money from CPC's Ministry Expansion Fund was used to help launch the ministry.] *Nireekshana* quickly outgrew the home. Now in several satellite clinics in Hyderabad and the state of

Andhra Pradesh, *Nireekshana* caters to the needs of

thousands of individuals and families. *Nireekshana* ACET (AIDS Care, Education & Treatment) is a community, Christian based organization dedicated to the compassionate care and support of people living with HIV/AIDS using a holistic approach. *Nireekshana's* work is based in the medical clinics and in community outreach. It's key work focus is on providing counseling, training, medical, socio-economic, spiritual care and support.

Please pray for the Suneethas and *Nireekshana* in these particular ways:

- That *Nireekshana* would truly be as the name literally means "A place of hope."
- That the Suneethas would be strengthened in their particular leadership roles.
- That God might supply the resources (financial, dedicated personnel, facilities) to continue this ministry.
