As we see God in His invitation and our praise, we cannot help but see how we have fallen short. God's Holy Scripture has the authority to reveal us to ourselves and transition our hearts to confession.

#### God Cleanses Us

Call to Confession

Deuteronomy 5.6-15, 6

LEADER: I am the Lord your God, who brought you

out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of

slavery.

**PEOPLE:** You shall have no other gods before me. LEADER: You shall not make for yourself a carved

image, or any likeness of anything that is in

heaven above, or that is on the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or serve them; for I the Lord your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.

PEOPLE: You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain.

LEADER: Observe the Sabbath day, to keep it holy, as the Lord your God commanded you. Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son or your daughter or your male servant, or your female servant, or your ox or your donkey or any of your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates, that your male servant and your female servant may rest as well as you. You shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God brought you out from there with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm. Therefore the Lord your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.

PEOPLE: I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

#### Corporate Confession of Sin

We sin in thought, word, and deed every week. This prayer, sometimes individual and silent confession, is a corporate confession uniting our voices as people equally and desperately in need of God's grace.

## Assurance of Pardon

Holy Scripture assures Christians, sinners saved by grace, that they are united to Jesus in His death and resurrection.

#### Assurance of Pardon

Romans 8.1-4

LEADER: Lift up your heads and hear the Good News:

"There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. For God has done what the law, weakened by flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit."



#### GOOD NEWS CLUB NEEDS YOUR HELP

The team at Good News Club is looking for help this summer as they minister to children throughout Chattanooga. The **specific need is for drivers** to transport youth volunteers to clubs. Summer Good News Clubs run from June 13 – end of July. Each club is 5 days long so they are asking for volunteers that are willing to sign up for one week of driving. Drivers are needed from 9 am -1pm for each week and would transport 2-3 youth volunteers.

Teenage volunteers are trained and will teach and counsel children in the understanding of the Gospel. These teams are supplemented with adult advisors and co-workers. These summer clubs reach about 3,500 children each year.

Chattanooga Sports Ministries exists to impact the urban youth of Chattanooga at the intersection of faith and athletic engagement by offering affordable sports programs. Within these programs, youth are pushed to become better athletes, better members of their community, and better followers of Christ. It has been pure joy for CPC to support this local ministry. This summer they have ways for us to get involved.

They are running an 8 week sports camp for 16 girls and boys teams. They are looking for small groups or families to "adopt-a-team" for the summer. This commitment includes: 1) praying for coaches and players of one team throughout the season, and 2) coordinating with the team coach to plan one fun outing, party, or picnic for the team!
