Here are a few updates on our tornado relief from today.

1. **Storage Shed Delivery:** If there is anyone available at **3:15 p.m. today** that can assist in unloading storage sheds in the back of the church building, please come by because we could use your help. We will need folk beginning at **9 a.m. tomorrow morning** to set these sheds up.
2. **Food/Water Deliveries:** We are gathering to snack pack at 10:30 a.m. and head out at 11 a.m. tomorrow. Please join us. We could use **non-perishable snacks/cookies, apples, and oranges.**
3. **Storage Bins:** We can still use more storage bins for future relief work. Please continue to drop them off at the church.
4. **Generators:** The church has become aware of some available generators. If you are without power and would like to use a generator, please let me know.
5. **Work Crews:**
  - There is a work crew scheduled from 4-8 p.m. **tomorrow** for Jason and Catherine Coffey who are in need of chainsaw and outdoor work. Please meet at the church and we will condense ourselves to avoid having too many vehicles onsite.
  - The Pearce's need a work crew with chainsaws for **this Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup>** at 9 a.m. at their home. They will need a large crew as their neighbors are in need of assistance as well. We will again gather at the church and set out from there.
  - There is a work crew scheduled for **next Saturday (4/25)** to assist with the Bradleys. More details to follow.
  - More crew needs will be forthcoming in the following days.
