There has been some frustration with the limited access to roads. These appear to be changing throughout the day, but we will try and keep you updated as best we can.

Here are a few updates and opportunities...

1. **Sunday, April 19:** will be a day of rest. We will suspend all work crew and distribution efforts for the day unless we hear of an urgent need.
2. **Storage Sheds:** We currently have eight empty storage sheds onsite at CPC. Please let us know if you need storage space beginning on Monday. Thank you for the construction crews who set these up!
3. **Bins:** We have plenty of storage bins and boxes at the church – as well as tarps. If your home (or a neighbor) needs these things, please let me know.
4. **Food Distribution:** We will begin only distributing food and water to work crews beginning next week. There are many restaurants and others who are providing hot meals onsite. If you are aware of food needs, however, please let me know and we will coordinate a delivery.
5. **Work Crews:** We will have work crews scheduled for next week. We will have a work crew scheduled for **Monday** beginning at 4 p.m. starting at the church.
