Consider Ecclesiastes 3:11

- A. Beauty is both culturally subjective and biblical objective. God makes all things beautiful in its time.
- B. Our hearts are prone to compare ourselves against others. We must be careful to avoid this.
- II. Slowing Down in a Fast-Paced World
 - A. We are often looking for what we want to see, not what God declares as beautiful.
 - B. We often attribute beauty to sources other than God.
- III. The Desire to Rule
