

This year we are again offering a choice on where you can spend your activity day. There will be three options for your group. Your entire group can only do one of the options, you may not split your group up. Also, this cost is included in the overall cost for The Edge.

You must choose your activity day option by April 28th.

Option 1 White Water Water Park (Outside Atlanta)

White Water is the largest water park in the southeast with tons of fun for groups of any size. Make sure that you encourage your students to bring towel, sunscreen and bathing suit to participate in this.

Option 2 White Water Rafting

Rafting will be on the Hiawasee River. Located in the Cherokee National Forest, the Hiawasee provides a laid-back, self-guided raft trip of about three hours, with five miles of easy Class I and II rapids flowing through a spectacular mountain gorge.

Transportation – You may either provide your own transportation or The Edge will provide transportation for you at a fee of \$10/per person.

Option 3 Tennessee Aquarium (Downtown Chattanooga)
